GOSPEL REFLECTION:

So often like Thomas we may say we do not know the way. It is not so much knowing the path as knowing the person of Jesus. The way is not a separate thing that leads us to Jesus. The way is Jesus. In a sense we are already there because we know and trust Jesus. In another sense, the path or way is what Jesus did. The First Reading shows us the care and concern that the early Church had for widows and those in need. The Church responded to that need by the selection of Deacons. Not only did they help with the distribution of food to the Greek-speaking widows, but they also ministered to them by proclaiming God's Word in their own language. Today there are many exercising a ministry of service in health care, looking after the physical needs of others, and of course, those who nurture family life.
