GOSPEL REFLECTION

On this day we remember “all souls,” who have died. They have passed beyond our sight; they have gone into a new and deeper dimension of the mystery of Christ. In a new way they share in the passion of Jesus. Our prayers and love follow them to the grave, but they have been entrusted for safe keeping into the arms of Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who received them from his Father; the Father who judges no one (Jn 5:22). The Father who “chose us in Christ before the foundation of the world” (Eph 1:4) and who does not abandon them when their world has fallen apart. In fact, the love of the Father opens a new and everlasting world for them. In remembering the deceased, we are remembering the saving work of Christ who came to save us from our sins and open the gates of heaven to his faithful people. The Preface of the Dead situates our prayers for the dead in the context of giving glory to our merciful Father. It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God, through Christ our Lord. In him the hope of blessed resurrection has dawned, that those saddened by the certainty of dying might be consoled by the promise of immortality to come. Indeed, for your faithful, Lord, life is changed not ended, and, when this earthly dwelling turns to dust, an eternal dwelling is made ready for them in heaven. And so, with Angels and Archangels, with Thrones and Dominions, and with all the hosts and Powers of heaven, we sing the hymn of your glory, as without end we acclaim: Holy, Holy, Holy Lord.....

PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR ALL SOULS OCTIVE

The Vatican's Apostolic Penitentiary, in its "**Enchiridion Indulgentiarum**" ("Handbook of Indulgences"), states that the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence for the faithful departed "everyday, from the 1st to the 8th of November," if, in addition to fulfilling the normal terms of a plenary indulgence, one "devoutly visit(s) a cemetery and at least mentally pray(s) for the dead."

A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ to remove the temporal punishment due to sin. In order to obtain a plenary indulgence the faithful must- in addition to being in the state of grace – both have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin (even venial sin), have sacramentally confessed their sins and received the Eucharist (either within or outside of Mass), and must pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.
