#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

In the silence after Communion, we are able to reflect on the great gift that God has given us. We were taught to pray in thanksgiving for the gift of Jesus in holy Communion from the time of our First Communion, but we should also pray that the Communion we have received may be effective in our lives. This time of prayer is more a time to realize that God continues to act in our lives. Thus, in Communion, the saving presence of Jesus continues the process of our salvation and transformation in Christ. The new life, which we received in Baptism is strengthened in Communion by our renewed encounter with the risen Lord. In other words, the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist is to transform us more and more into the one Body of Christ. For this reason, the Prayer after Communion itself rarely give thanks to God for the gift of Communion, but most often it prays that what we have received may be effective in our lives. What we have done in praising God and what we have received for our transformation into Christ is given not just for us alone, but for the transformation of the whole world.

Fasting is defined as having no more than one full meal and two small meals (though themselves not equal to a full meal), Of course, women who are pregnant or anyone with a medical condition are not bound to the law of fasting but should consider another suitable penance. Ash Wednesday is a day to prayerfully reflect on our Lord as we begin a season (Lent) of prayer and penance.
