#### GOSPEL REFLECTION GOSPEL REFLECTION

Last Sunday's Gospel of the woman at the well reminded us of the living waters of Baptism that satisfy our thirst. This Sunday the Gospel opens for us the new sight that Baptism bestows. This is a spiritual insight that lets us recognize Jesus as the Son of God and Saviour of the world. This is the work and gift of the Holy Spirit who bestows a new awareness of God's activity in the world. The man born blind was not born blind because of sin, but as Jesus said to show forth the glory of God. Physically blind, he clearly sees that Jesus is the Christ and professes his faith in him as Lord. The religious leaders who have sight are blind to God's presence in his Son. Those who are baptized must continually pray for Christ's gift of enlightenment that they will continue to share in his work by being the light of the world. The focal point of the Gospel is when Jesus says to the formerly blind man: "You have seen the Son of Man, the one speaking with you is he." This is the same point from last Sunday when Jesus told the woman at the well: "I am the Messiah, the one speaking to you." Both of them respond in faith that they believe. We can respond in the same way.


