GOSPEL REFLECTION

Today's Gospel speaks to us about the situation of Christians today, just as it did when it was written. As in the days of the apostles, practicing Christians are now a minority, both in the face of others who called themselves Christians but do nothing about it and those who do not believe in God. The danger is that the believer feels isolated and gives in to the majority. Jesus reminds us that this happens even in our families. The Gospel reflects the experience of the early church. When a person became a believer in Christ, it could affect the harmony and cohesion of his or her whole family. It may well be that we are back to that situation today. The conscious choice of discipleship and our full engagement with it can indeed be disconcerting if not disruptive for our families and friends. Can our commitment and allegiance to Christ be a priority even above and before the members of our family? For this reason the Lord prays for the earth to be set on fire. The fire represents both a purifying agent and the flame of the Holy Spirit's zeal. Let us pray for the strength and zeal of the Holy Spirit not only to remain faithful to Christ but also to be witnesses to his new life.


