#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

In ancient times as sometimes in our own, people with physical infirmities were regarded as a burden to society. In Jesus' time they were abandoned by their families and forced to beg for food and money in the streets. They had no status, power or wealth for anyone to notice them. Jesus is different, living the tradition of the Old Testament of his Father, he hears the cry of the poor and attends to the needs of the destitute. He sees the man born blind in today's Gospel and reaches out to him. This gives us confidence that God takes notice of us. We have the knowledge that God sees us, cares for us, and wants to develop a close relationship with us. However, this calls for humility on our part, for we must acknowledge and accept our own infirmities and need for God's healing. This message is also intended for those preparing for Baptism and Initiation into the Church at Easter. Baptism is the Sacrament of Enlightenment. So, we pray that they will join us in seeing our blindness and need for healing to see God's gift of new life. In this way we become the ones who encounter Jesus and experience his saving and compassionate touch, that opens for us a new life.
