GOSPEL REFLECTION

Christ the King has more than human power. He has divine power to forgive sins and reconcile the human race to God the Father. The good thief, St. Dismas, is an example of this. He inherits the Kingdom of God because he turns to Christ the universal King and Good Shepherd for mercy and forgiveness. He responds and cooperates with God's grace, and gives all humanity the hope of forgiveness, life and salvation. As we gather at the Holy Eucharist, we have the opportunity to respond and cooperate with God's plan of salvation. This is our opportunity to say "yes" to Jesus, to love as He loves, to build some small part of heaven here to earth, so that we and many others can go from earth to heaven, to live with our King forever. As Jesus often said: "The Kingdom of God is near". Our Christian life is about acquiring a taste for heaven now, about becoming heavenly now, about making sure we never take heaven for granted. 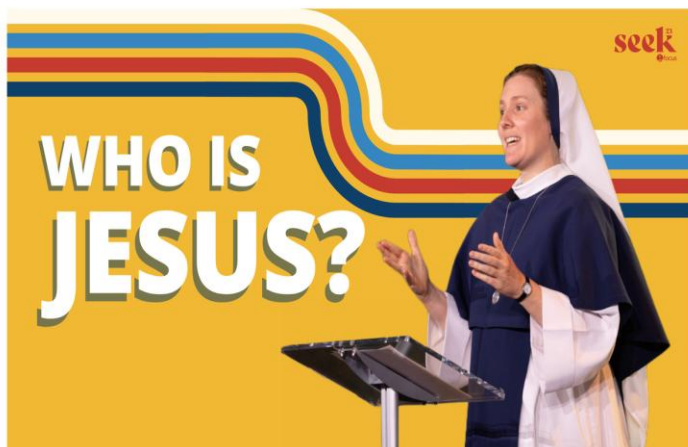
