GOSPEL REFLECTION:

The first part of the Gospel focusses on reconciliation within the community; the second part of the Gospel focusses on the unity of the community around Christ. We need to overcome the rampant individualism of our age to reawaken the awareness that we are communities gathered by Jesus. We are a community, a people, called and formed by God in Christ Jesus. And so we gather to listen to his Gospel, to keep alive his memory, to be inspired with his Spirit, to welcome in ourselves his joy and his peace, to announce his Good News. The future of the Christian faith will depend for the most part on what we Christians do in our actual communities during the coming decades. We cannot pin our hopes on others, whether popes, bishops or priests. Our only hope is Jesus Christ. We are the ones who have to centre our Christian communities in the person of Jesus as the only force capable of regenerating our worn-out and routine faith: the only one who is capable of attracting today's men and women; the only one capable of bringing to birth a new faith in these times of unbelief. The renewal of the Church is urgent, but there is nothing so decisive as returning radically to Jesus Christ.
