**GOSPEL REFLECTION:**

Today's Readings present us with two aspects of the witnesses of the Resurrection. Mary of Magdala, Peter and John testify to the empty tomb. At the tomb, there was something that convinced them that the body of Jesus was not just gone, but that he was resurrected. It was the burial cloths. In the revival of Lazarus we saw that strips of cloth were wrapped around the large burial cloth, making the body look like a mummy. The body of Jesus was gone, but the cloths had not been unwrapped. How else could the body of Jesus have been removed without unbinding the strips of cloth. Thus, the disciples saw and believed. But the empty tomb is not the only evidence of the resurrection, Jesus appeared in the flesh to Mary, and as the First Reading tells us, the Apostles ate and drank with Jesus after his Resurrection. But we know from the Gospels themselves that the Apostles' belief was also mixed with doubt and confusion at first. It is the same for us, we believe but it takes time for us to understand fully what the resurrection means for us. Without Christ in our lives, the world would be like an empty tomb. Let us pray more earnestly in this time of pandemic that the presence of the risen Christ will fill our lives, our homes and the world with his peace. The Lord is risen! The Lord is risen indeed! Alleluia!

**From Archbishop Mulhall – Returning to Sunday Mass:** I understand there are still some members of the faithful who, for reasons of health, do not yet feel able to return to Mass. It has always been the teaching of the Church that it is not a breach of the Sunday Obligation when a Catholic is impeded from attending Mass in person because of situations such as ill health or care for the sick. We are a Eucharistic people for whom attendance at Mass is essential. I invite all Catholics who have not yet done so to return to attending Mass in person this Pentecost Sunday, May 28, 2023. Nourished by our encounter with the Risen Lord Jesus, fed by His Body and Blood in Holy Communion, we receive the grace and strength to serve the Lord and glorify Him with our lives. It is to be the foundation stone of our lives, bringing together every aspect of our life and mission. In the days to come let us cultivate a deeper desire for the Real Presence of the Lord. The Eucharist is the cause of our deepest joy, enabling us to offer our profoundest thanks to God.

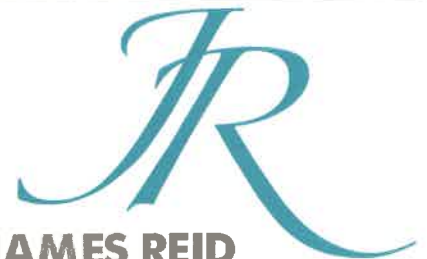
