#### GOSPEL REFLECTION

Today's Gospel from Saint John expresses God's words to us about how to live with the Lord Jesus. Jesus' challenge to know the Father through him is an invitation to enter into a loving relationship with him. The Father is known only in relationships in the same way that love is only known. Love is not a physical object to be possessed, and neither is the Father. Just as love is known between two people, so the Father is only known in our relationship with Jesus. Jesus and the Father are one. If we are one with Jesus, then we are also one with the Father. Jesus invites us to know him through his Word, through his Body which is the Church and through our union with him in the Eucharist. So often like Thomas, we may say we do not know the way. It is not so much knowing the path as knowing the person of Jesus. The way is Jesus. In a sense we are already there because we know and trust Jesus. In another sense, the path or way is what Jesus did. Life is about living this mystery of God's love for us and responding to His Word. That Word will change us and transform us. If we do not heed the Word, we stumble and fall. May this Sunday of the Easter Season help us give ourselves more completely to Christ. The Gospel teaches us how.
