**GOSPEL REFLECTION:**

The journey theme of the Emmaus story is not only about the distance between Jerusalem and Emmaus, it is also about the painful and gradual journey of words that must descend from the head to the heart; it is about coming to faith, a return to a proper relationship with the stranger who is Jesus the Lord. The Lord always listens to us and is always there, especially when times are hard, when one has fallen, experiences doubt, disillusionment, and frustration. His words make the hearts of the disciples “burn” – as they move them from the darkness of sadness and desperation, provoking in them the desire to remain with him: “Stay with us, Lord”. The dejected disciples begin to change only when they are enlightened by the Risen Christ, who explains from the Sacred Scriptures how God works in a resistant world and among resistant, sinful people like us. It is indeed an ironic victory because the forces of rejection and experiences of suffering and sinfulness, themselves, become the means by which God’s purpose is accomplished in the world!
