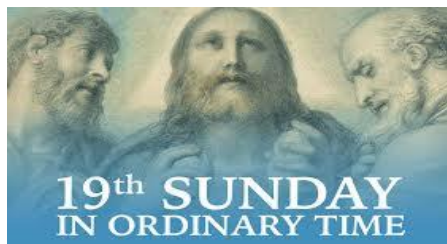

**GOSPEL REFLECTION:**

In the Gospel, nature unleashes its full power in the wind and the waves. And similar to the encounter Elijah has, the coming of Jesus across the waters is an encounter with God. Jesus manifests his divinity in his power to calm the storm and the troubled hearts of Peter and the disciples. We are aware of the destructive power of natural events and the destructive power that we, human beings, can exert in our world. In all of this, we can sometimes wonder where God can be found. And yet, we should remember that the God who encountered Elijah in the gentle breeze, and the God who walked towards the disciples across the waters and stilled the waves, is always at work. Jesus is always present in the midst of even the worst difficulties to bring us through it with him. However, that path requires that we look not just at the difficulties and troubles, but look for God's presence amidst the turmoil with the eyes of faith to find Christ gently yet powerfully at work. We can trust that Christ will find for us a secure path through the difficulties, and, in so doing, bring us to a greater faith in him. For when the events in our lives are challenging and difficult, they can become times when God shows himself most clearly to us. As such, they become a place where we encounter God. And such encounters can leave us in even greater awe of his love and care for us.

**Attention Parishioners:** Do you have trouble understanding what is said in church? Because the sound echoes and reverberates in our church, people often have trouble understanding what is said even if they do not have any loss of hearing. If you have this difficulty please use a receiver with ear buds or headphones. You control the volume of your device. These receivers reduce background noise and amplify a speaker's voice for clearer communication. A transmitter connects to our sound system and delivers the sound directly to the individual receivers. You can pick up the receiver on your way into church and return them on your way out. They are found by the window in the alcove in the Gathering Area (Vestibule-Atrium). It is better if you use your own ear bugs or headphones, but a few are provided by the parish. You can also use a small FM radio tuned to 91.5.

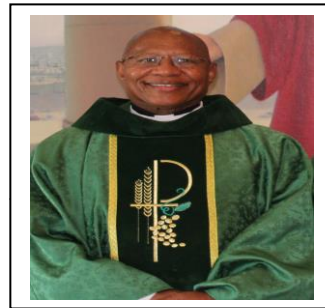
