GOSPEL REFLECTION:

The covid-19 pandemic has brought home a truth: the Eucharist is at the heart of the Church. It is the dynamic, beating heart of the Church. Just as a beating heart pulls the blood into it and then sends it out throughout the body, so the Eucharist draws us together, in order to send us out. Thus Saint Paul the Apostle preached that the entire life of a Christian is a prolongation of the Eucharist, as a spiritual sacrifice offered to God in union with Christ. For this reason, Saint Paul exhorted his hearers to offer themselves as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God. Whenever we come to Mass and receive the Eucharist, we are making a number of important statements. We are acknowledging Jesus as our bread of life, as the one who alone can satisfy our deepest hungers. We are also declaring that we will follow in his way and be faithful to him all our lives, in response to his faithfulness to us. The celebration and reception of the Eucharist should be our strength and joy, a commitment in faith and love that gives meaning to all our existence. This is the message for each of us today as well and the heart of our religion and worship, in spirit and in truth.
