GOSPEL REFLECTION:

In the Second Reading from the Letter to the Romans, Saint Paul also encourages his readers to dedicate themselves completely to God. In response to God's unbounded mercy, each follower of Christ is to offer a total oblation of self-giving to God. Paul speaks of offering one's body, which means the entire person in fact, and not doing so reluctantly or half-heartedly, but willingly and joyfully. It is then considered an offering that is living, holy and acceptable to God. The offering of ourselves to God is not once and for all, but a life-long endeavour and effort, a constant interior renewal. This conversion of life is closely connected to Christ's teaching about denying ourselves and taking up his cross and following him. This involves a change of direction and heart. An excellent way to sum up the teaching this Sunday is the phrase "actions, not words." Our worship of God must be first of all a life of selfless service, inspired by God's merciful dealings with us, an imitation of Christ, our Way, Truth and Life.
