GOSPEL REFLECTION:

The Holy Spirit is the hardest person of the Trinity to describe or imagine. Yet there are many descriptions or images used in Scripture. The Spirit is described as living water which flows to all living things to refresh and enliven in order to make them flourish with virtues and gifts appropriate to their needs and vocations. The Spirit is referred to “the wind that blows where it will”. The wind is the air that keeps us alive all the time; we only notice it when, occasionally, it gives us a push. The wind can be a powerful force. In Hebrew the same word describes both Spirit and breath. Also, so Jesus breathes the Spirit upon the Apostles, just as God did at creation into the human formed from the dust of the earth. The Spirit is this breath of God that gives us life. The Spirit is the Paraclete or Advocate, the friend or counsellor who stands by us, who opens our eyes to see, and our hearts to hear and love. It is by the Spirit that we can say, “Jesus is LORD!” The Spirit is also the Spirit of Truth, which also means loyalty. Being loyal is an act of love. The Spirit is the divine Love flowing eternally from the Father and the Son, from the Father through the Son. In that Love the Father and the Son eternally love us, and so the Spirit is the Love of the Father and the Son that flows into the world, to transform people into God’s friends, creating a loyalty towards the Father whose Son we receive in love.
