GOSPEL REFLECTION

This week we begin the holiest week of the church year. Palm Sunday, the day when we commemorate Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem, begins His Passion. On this day we will hear the passion read for the first of two times during Holy Week. We receive the palms to remind us of what this week will bring.

On Thursday, we are invited to begin the Easter Triduum at 6:00 pm. For us these three days are a parish retreat and are the most important days of the church calendar. For it is on these three days that we will recall the saving events of Christ's passion and gather as the people of God to give thanks for the salvation won for us by Christ. These days are marked by both sorrow and joy, as we are led by the liturgy through the mystery of redemption and the gift of eternal life.

The celebration of the Easter Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on the evening of Holy Thursday, which marks Jesus' Last Supper with his friends, the washing of the apostles' feet, and the institution of the Eucharist. This Mass of the Lord's Supper ends with a procession with the Holy Eucharist to a chapel of reposition and a time of adoration.

Good Friday is a day of fasting and mourning, focussed on the passion of Jesus and the adoration of the Cross, always in the context of the resurrection. On this day we continue with the reading of the passion from the Gospel of John, followed by the Veneration of the Cross. To accommodate everyone we have two Services at 12 noon or 3:00 pm.

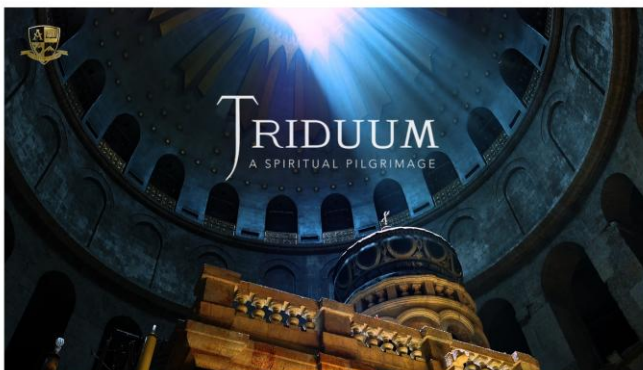
