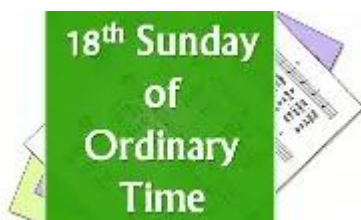

GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel Jesus did not say to the Apostles, 'I will give them something to eat,' but, 'you give them something to eat.'" He accepted their meagre contribution, by not setting their provisions aside, but by using them. Jesus took what they had and gave thanks." He allowed the bounty to appear as coming from themselves. In other words, the gift of God does not displace us from our lives; it does not take over from us and make our efforts redundant. On the contrary, it is in the struggle of our efforts that the gift of God appears. This miracle combines the natural with the supernatural. God always invites us to participate with him, even in the gift of salvation. With the little we give, God supplies the rest, but it must start with our responding and giving. So it is in the Mass. We must offer ourselves, which is symbolized in the procession of the bread and wine brought to the altar by members of the church. The priest, acting in the person of Christ, takes the bread, says the blessing and then gives it to the faithful. We offer bread and wine to the priest, and through this action of the priest, Jesus makes himself present and feeds us with the Bread of Life, broken for us all.

Healing Service

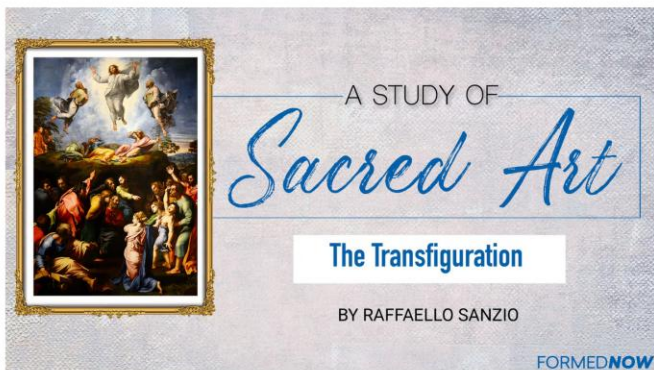
