GOSPEL REFLECTION:

There is a natural progression in the Gospels. On the first few Sundays of Easter, we saw the empty tomb and Jesus' appearances to the apostles. Now we are reading Jesus' instructions to his disciples as he is inviting them to enter more deeply into the mystery of his life with the Father and the Holy Spirit. There is a difference between believing that Jesus rose from the dead and believing in Jesus. The first is like saying "I know my spouse exists"; the second is saying "I believe in my spouse." I think a loved one would be put off if all we could say about them is that I know they exist. That sounds so detached, so impersonal. To say we believe in a person is to indicate that we have a relationship with them. So, the Gospels invite us to believe in the resurrection of Jesus and that he is risen, but they do not stop there. That is just the starting point. They invite us into a more intimate friendship, to know this Jesus who rose from the dead. This is what we call entering into the mystery of our faith and salvation. It is the Holy Spirit who empowers and nourishes this relationship with Jesus.
